



2021 Registration Guidelines

Dear competitors,

As of April 3rd, 2021, [the Province of Ontario has put into place a "provincewide emergency brake"](#) that restricts/prohibits indoor and outdoor gatherings for businesses. This prevents us from having a banquet to celebrate the 2020 season as well as our traditional open-house. However, Ontario Time Attack will still **open our events for registration on April 17th, 2021** on [MSReg](#). Our events are still planned to proceed as usual with following basic rules:

- All participants will need to strictly follow social distancing guidelines.
- No spectators will be admitted to the track.
- It is highly recommended that participants wear masks that cover the nose and mouth when outside of their cars.
- Bring your own hand sanitizer or hand cleaning supplies.
- Please do not attend the event if you are ill, have [Covid-19 symptoms](#) or if you are at risk for severe illness.
- No passengers, ride-alongs (unless from same household) or in-car instruction will be allowed.
- No sharing of cars between drivers unless from the same household.

Due to the unpredictable nature of all events due to Covid measures, the OTA organizing committee will review registrations **1 week prior to each event date** and total up the revenue that has been paid for that respective event. We will then determine whether enough has been collected to cover the costs of running the event. If we have collected enough fees to cover the costs, the event will proceed and **all fees will not be refundable**.

If OTA has not collected enough fees to cover the costs, then OTA will cancel the respective event and all those who have paid will receive a full refund promptly.

Assuming that the event takes place, no refunds will be available, without exceptions. For clarity – there will be no refunds for mechanical breakdowns, adverse weather, personal or work schedule changes or illness. Competitors can transfer their fee to another driver who has been signed off by OTA to compete if 24 hours notice is provided to OTA.

The format of all events will be the typical OTA event – morning lapping, lunch break, followed by afternoon competition. You will have about 2 hours of quality seat time.

OTA will not provide lunch, coffee or water and participants are advised that local restaurant facilities may not be available. It is recommended that participants bring their own food, water, face masks and hand sanitizer. Additional guidance for social distancing, arrivals, registrations and other logistics will be sent out to registrants in each event's Supplementary Regulations.

Due to the fluidity of the situation, OTA reserves the right to cancel the event in its entirety for other reasons – for example if the Province changes its social gathering limits. In this event a full refund will be provided promptly. OTA intends to hold events when it is possible to do so given Provincial limits, safety and other considerations.

We will see you on the track (from at least 2 meters away)!
