



MEDIA REGISTRATION FORM

Rules and requirements for media

- 1) This form is intended only for individuals who are capturing photos/video for actual publication purposes. Individual social media pages, websites, or accounts managed by freelancers designed for profit do not classify as a media organization. If you require track side access to provide content for a team or competitor, this form must be completed by the team or competitor on behalf of you. Both pages of this form must be signed and completed.
- 2) Flying drones anywhere at all Ontario Time Attack (OTA) events is prohibited.
- 3) Long pants are encouraged and closed-toe shoes are required.
- 4) You are required to provide and wear your own high visibility vest; one will not be provided for you.
 - a. For events held at Canadian Tire Motorsport Park, a CTMP media bib will be provided. Sharing of the CTMP bib is prohibited. Media bib must be returned at the end of the day, if not this can result in the denial of future OTA events.
- 5) All content taken at the event cannot be sold. Exception to this is if you are providing content for a team or competitor, see #1.
- 6) Photo-video rules
 - a. Stay clear of the wall – no equipment to be placed on top of the wall or leaning against the wall, and do not sit/lean against the wall.
 - b. Do not lean against any catch fences. At photo holes, do not stick any equipment beyond the catch fence.
 - c. Tripods are not permitted except for video. Selfie sticks are not permitted. Monopods may be used on the ground to provide stability to a camera, but not to extend the reach of the camera and may not be held out over the racing surface (including pit lane) at any time.
 - d. No sitting or lying on the ground. You are permitted to kneel on one knee but strongly recommend that you do not in case you must move quickly. Always have an escape plan before you start shooting.
 - e. Move well away from the track if you are not watching the track. Do not update social media near the wall or catch fence.
 - f. Listen to all corner marshals, do what they ask. If you have a disagreement, please reach out to one of the OTA officials to discuss further. Do not interfere with corner marshals and/or safety personnel. Do not walk or stand in front of safety vehicles.
- 7) Mandatory media meeting will be held at 8:15AM near driver registration. Safety rules will be reviewed along with any additional information not captured in these rules and requirement. A wrist band will be provided at the end of the meeting. A wrist band will be required to shoot trackside alongside with the high visibility vest or media bib, otherwise you will be restricted to areas where spectators are permitted to go to.
